### AGREEMENT FOR MEDICAL SERVICES AND COMPENSATION

This Agreement made and entered into this \_\_\_ day of November, 2008, by and between **Henry County Medical Center** of Paris, Henry County, Tennessee, a duly authorized Tennessee Hospital District (herein "HCMC"), **Henry County, Tennessee** (herein "Henry County"), and **Henry County Sheriff's Department**, Henry County, Tennessee (herein "Sheriff's Department").

#### RECITALS:

- 1. HCMC is a general acute care hospital whose mission is to deliver quality comprehensive medical services to the people of Henry County and its surrounding area.
- The Sheriff's Department is the law enforcement agency for Henry County,
   Tennessee and houses county and state prisoners in its county jail.
- 3. The Sheriff's Department, as the agent of Henry County, Tennessee, has a duty to provide medical attention to all county prisoners confined to its county jail.
- 4. Henry County and HCMC utilize county prisoners to perform certain services for its use and benefit on Henry County and HCMC properties.
- The parties wish to reduce to writing their agreement as to the medical care and treatment of Henry County prisoners and the compensation to be paid to HCMC for its services.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing recitals, the mutual promises and covenants hereinafter contained, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

1. HCMC agrees to care and treat Henry County prisoners when called upon to do so

by the Henry County Sheriff's Department.

- HCMC agrees to provide and grant to Henry County a sixty percent (60%)
   discount for all medical costs and expenses charged for the care and treatment of Henry
   County prisoners.
- 3. HCMC further agrees to grant and allow a credit of \$3.00 for every hour a county prisoner is utilized by HCMC for services performed while on any property maintained and operated by HCMC, or while performing services for the use and benefit of HCMC.
- 4. HCMC shall maintain a record of hours worked and credits received by the Sheriff's Department on at least a monthly basis and provide a monthly report to the Sheriff's Department of said hours worked and credits granted to HCMC. Any disputes which may arise as to the amount of credits to be granted to the Sheriff's Department shall be resolved by the HCMC Administrator and the Henry County Sheriff, or their duly designated agents.
- 5. In addition to the sixty percent (60%) discount granted herein to the Sheriff's Department, the Sheriff's Department may elect, at its discretion, to apply accumulated credits as above described to any balance owed to HCMC for the medical care and treatment of county prisoners who required medical attention while said county prisoners were providing services to or on behalf of HCMC.

The allowable credit shall only apply to those HCMC charges incurred by county prisoners while providing services for the use and benefit of HCMC at the time medical care and treatment was tendered to the county prisoners, and not otherwise.

6. Henry County agrees to pay the balance of the medical charges (40% after discount) within 120 days of the billing date.

- 7. The effective date of this Agreement is November 1, 2008. Either party may terminate this Agreement for any cause by providing the other party thirty (30) days written notice of its intent to terminate this Agreement.
- 8. This Agreement may be amended only by a writing signed by both parties hereto.

  This Agreement and the rights, duties and obligations shall not be assignable by either party.
- 9. This Agreement shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Tennessee.
- 10. This Agreement shall be binding upon, and inure to the benefit of, the parties hereto and their respective heirs, successors, assigns, and personal and legal representatives.
