Be it remembered that the County Commission met in a regular session at the Courthouse in Henry County, Tennessee on December 17, 2012 at 7:00 PM. Present and presiding the Honorable Brent Greer, Chairman, Donna Craig, County Clerk and the County Commissioners:

ITEM NO. 1 The meeting was called to order by Sheriff's Dept. Captain Damon Lowe.

ITEM NO. 2 The invocation was led by Commissioner Humphreys.

ITEM NO. 3 The pledge to the flag was led by Commissioner Paschall.

ITEM NO. 4 Roll Call

The following Commissioners were present: Wesley Bradley, Dell Carter, Greg Carter, Bobby Freeman, Kenneth Humphreys, Don Jones, Paul Mathenia, Connie McSwain, Paul Neal, Dan Paschall, Monte Starks, James Travis, Marty Visser, David Webb. Absent: Kreg Kyle.

ITEM NO. 5 Citizen's Forum

NONE AND THE CHAIR CLOSED THE FORUM

ITEM NO. 6 Commissioner's Forum

- Commissioner Paschall - Stated that he would like to make a motion requesting that the Commission send a resolution to officials asking for a ban on assault rifles and violent video games.
- Commissioner Neal – Expressed that we need to look into bringing prayer back into our schools.
- Commissioner Travis – Expressed his differing opinion regarding bringing prayer back into our schools. He feels that if prayer is held at home and we exercised renewed focus on strengthening families, we would not need prayer in schools.
- Commissioner Bradley – Stated that our hearts are heavy at this time and agreed that banning assault weapons will help the situation, but asked the question of what we could do now. He thinks if each of our schools had a school resource officer with a patrol car parked in front this could deter violent acts. He thinks we need two officers at the High School and emphasized the necessity of the Commission budgeting for this.

- Commissioner Webb – Concurred with Commissioner Bradley and would also like to include PSSD. He is not comfortable voting on a motion brought from the floor and thinks a resolution should be drafted and properly worded by the legislative committee prior to sending it to the state and federal government. It would then be brought back to the Commission to vote.
- Commissioner Mathenia – Stated that outlawing guns is not the solution because that won't stop people from committing violent acts. We need to spend our time and resources examining mental health issues.
- Commissioner Neal – Would like to know how many people with gun permits have committed a violent act.
- Commissioner Travis – Stated that this is a good body to be around and hoped this discussion will not cause any problems. He is a veteran and his experience in the military was that he was only allowed to carry a weapon while on duty. He asked how civilians think they have the right to have access to these weapons when the military doesn't.
- Commissioner Starks – Wanted to know what we could do to help Henry County. He thinks the first thing we should do is get with Director Miles and discuss what measures we can take to prevent violent acts from happening in our county.
- Commissioner Dell Carter – Explained to the Commission that Grove School has a buzz-in system in place and has an officer on site. He expressed his opinion that the violent acts reflect back to how our children are raised.


Valerie Carter be appointed to the Regional Library Board to fill the unexpired term of Rose Cunningham to end in June 2014.

WHEREAS, the County Mayor's Office of Emergency Management has completed an update of the 2007 Henry County Hazard Mitigation Plan, and was submitted to the Federal Emergency Management Agency and the Tennessee Emergency Management Agency for consideration and approval; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency and the Tennessee Emergency Management Agency have given approval of the updated 2012 Henry County Hazard Mitigation Plan as of November 7, 2012, it shall be distributed to jurisdictions, agencies and county municipalities for local adoption completion, and all Federal emergency funding and grants are conditioned upon adoption of updated plan.


