





SECTION 2. The Department of Economic and Community Development may from time to time monitor the county's compliance with federal Title VI regulations.





WHEREAS, on June 26, 2009, Governor Phil Bredesen signed into law new legislation making counties responsible for the cost of outpatient and inpatient mental health evaluations and treatment for defendants charged only with misdemeanors and court ordered to undergo said evaluations (see T.C.A. §33-7-304, Public Chapter 531 Section 45); and

WHEREAS, before the adoption of the T.C.A. §33-7-304, Public Chapter 531 Section 45 the State of Tennessee paid all costs and expenses for outpatient and inpatient mental health evaluations and treatment ordered by the court for defendants charged with both misdemeanors and felonies; and

WHEREAS, this unfunded mandate transferred the cost of outpatient and inpatient mental health evaluations and treatments for criminal defendants charged only with misdemeanors from the State of Tennessee to the individual counties has resulted in serious financial ramifications for Henry County, Tennessee already with the potential for untold cost in the future; and

WHEREAS, after receiving bills for mental health evaluations at state mental health facilities for defendants charged with misdemeanor offenses from the Department of Mental Health and Developmental Disabilities, the Henry County Legislative Body voted to request that the State Legislators representing Henry County sponsor legislation to repeal "T.C.A. §33-7-304, Public Chapter 531 Section 45" and again require the State of Tennessee to absorb or pay state mental health facilities and

agencies who perform court ordered mental evaluations and treatment for criminal defendants charged with misdemeanors; and

WHEREAS, the Henry County Legislative Body further directed the County Mayor and the County Attorney to forward a copy of the Resolution asking for the repeal of "T.C.A. §33-7-304, Public Chapter 531 Section 45" to each of the remaining ninety-four (94) counties requesting their assistance and support in seeking the repeal of "T.C.A. §33-7-304, Public Chapter 531 Section 45."







PART 28 WAIVER

67-5-2801. Personal property taxes, penalties and interest, and attorney fees and costs — Waiver of enforcement and collection.

(a) The local tax administrative officers, being the county trustee with respect to county personal property taxes and the comparable tax collecting officers in a municipality with respect to municipal property taxes, may request the delinquent tax attorney to seek court approval in order to waive the enforcement and collection of all, but not a portion of, personal property taxes, penalties and interest in cases in which the tax collecting officers determine, after reviewing the facts and circumstances, that:

- (1) The business or enterprise that was subject to the tax levy had ceased all business operations;
- (2) The personal property of an out-of-existence business or enterprise cannot be located after diligent search and inquiry; and
- (3) Neither fraud nor an intention to avoid payment of the taxes on the part of the business or enterprise caused the circumstances giving rise to such waiver.

(b) Any waiver under this part shall be included and set forth as a credit in the monthly settlement and annual statement pursuant to §§ 67-5-1903 and 67-5-1904.

(c) With respect to personal property taxes, penalties and interest for which no delinquent tax lawsuit has been filed, but for which court approval has been sought and obtained for waiver as provided in subsection (a), the local tax administrative officers shall provide a report to the chief executive officer of the local government of the taxes, penalties and interest waived under this section. With respect to delinquent personal property taxes, for which the delinquent lawsuit has been filed, the court having jurisdiction of the delinquent tax lawsuit may, upon motion and a finding that the factors outlined in subdivisions (a)(1)-(3) exist, order the waiver of enforcement and collection of all, but not a portion of, such personal property taxes, penalties and interest, and attorney fees and costs.
