#### **RESOLUTION NO. 8-10-08**

## A RESOLUTION OF THE HENRY COUNTY, TENNESSEE, BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TO AUTHORIZE CONSTRUCTION AT GROVE SCHOOL, PROVIDE THE MEANS OF FINANCING, AND AUTHORIZE THE PURCHASE OF WESTON HALL

WHEREAS, the County operates a school on the property commonly known as "Grove Hill"; and

WHEREAS, the Henry County Board of Education does conclude that certain renovations and construction ought to be undertaken on this property; and

WHEREAS, the County Commission desires to approve such project, authorize the financing therefore, and for other purposes; and

WHEREAS the County does further find it to be in the best interest of the County that the County purchase the Weston Hall property from the Henry County Board of Education.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Henry County, Tennessee, assembled in regular session on this the 20th day of October, 2008, a majority or more of the membership concurring that:

- 1. The Henry County Board of Education is authorized to spend an amount, not exceeding one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00), from existing funds on new construction on the Grove property,
- 2. That the Board of Commissioners authorizes the borrowing of an amount, not to exceed two million five-hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000.00), for purposes of the Grove project. This amount shall only be borrowed when it appears that market conditions are favorable for a bond issue. This financing would be done in the following means:
- (A) An existing school bond be extended in its term by one year,
  - (B) That the term of the borrowing for the Grove project be such

that the bond would be finally retired at the same time as the existing school bond. The amortization of the new bond for the Grove project should be an amount averaging one hundred and fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000.00) per year over 18 years.

(C) That the debt for the Grove project be serviced by existing

funds of the Henry County Board of Education and that no taxes be raised for this

purpose.

(D) That the County purchase the Weston Hall property from the

Henry County Board of Education for \$225,000.00, that

payment be made only when the bond resolution authorizing

bonds for the Grove project is passed, that the proceeds be used solely for the project

and that as a condition of such sale the Board of Education agrees to give the County

ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) of in-kind goods and services per year for utilities,

custodial expenses, and maintenance expenses, and that this in kind payment be made

for five years following the date of purchase.

3. That this action be followed with an appropriate bond resolution to

authorize a bond for the Grove project that as above described and that, thereafter, the

expenditures for the Grove project be reflected in the budget of the Henry County

Board of Education, and, as necessary, be reflected in appropriate budget amendments.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that a true copy of this Resolution be

spread upon the Commission record of this date.
