NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Henry County, Tennessee, assembled in regular session on the 21st day of October, 2013, a two-thirds (2/3) majority or more concurring, that pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated 8-10-101, § (a) (2) and Tennessee Code Annotated 8-10-101 § (3) (A) of the State of Tennessee, the term of Constable of Henry County, Tennessee, be increased from a term of two years to a term of four years, to be effective at the regular election next following the passage of this resolution and thereafter the Office of Constable shall be for a term of four years.
